



Covid Protocol Entry Requirements (as of 1/5/22)

The 2022 Sony Open in Hawaii will follow guidelines by the City and County of Honolulu in proof of vaccination or proof of negative covid test. All individuals attending the tournament and related events will need to follow these protocols:

- Proof of full vaccination along with an identification bearing the same identification information as proof of full vaccination. A photograph/digital copy of the identification will also be accepted.

A hard copy of a state-approved or government-issued vaccination card; a photograph/digital copy of a state-approved or government-issued vaccination card;

"Full vaccination" means two weeks have passed after the second dose in a two-dose COVID-19 vaccination series or two weeks have passed after a single-dose COVID-19 vaccination. Such vaccinations must be authorized for emergency use or approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration or the World Health Organization, regardless of whether a COVID-19 vaccine booster has been received.

OR

- Proof of negative COVID-19 test result along with an identification bearing the same identification information and negative COVID-19 test results.

Test result must have been taken within 48 hours prior to entry and must be from an FDA approved or FDA EUA approved molecular or antigen test. **Home tests are not acceptable proof of negative test result.**

Exceptions: Children 12 and under.

Verification Confirmation at the 2022 Sony Open in Hawaii

Once an individual is confirmed that they have provided the correct documentation and identification for proof of vaccination or proof of negative COVID test result (within 48 hours), they will be given a wristband before entering the tournament grounds. They will need to wear the wristband throughout the tournament. Checkpoints will be located near or at the tournament admission gates during the week.
